On April 07, 2025, Saudi Arabia's accession as a Contracting Party to the 1999 Geneva Act of the Hague Agreement entered into force, facilitating the international protection of industrial designs in this country.

With Saudi Arabia, the 1999 Geneva Act now has 76 contracting parties, expanding the international protection options for designers and companies.
